CAT A cat 9 months and over on the day of the show.
KITTEN A kitten under 9 months on the day of the show.
JUNIOR Cat 9 months to 2 years on the day of the show.
INTERMEDIATE Cat aged between 2 and 5 years on the day of the show.
SENIOR Cat aged between 5 and 7 years on the day of the show.
VETERAN Cat aged 7 years and over on the day of the show.

SHORTHAIR A sleek coated cat whose fur lies flat on the body.
LONGHAIR A cat whose coat is more than one inch long and stands from its body.
