SETTING UP:

Help will be required from 1.30 pm on the afternoon of Friday, 16th April for setting up of cages and again on Saturday after the show to breakdown the show cages. An hour of your time is all that is needed and would be much appreciated each day. Snacks provided after set up on Friday, and a workers raffle will be drawn after the hall is cleared on Saturday.

DONATIONS, RIBBONS, etc: The Show Committee would be most grateful for any donations of ribbons, rosettes, one win prizes or a monetary donation to purchase these items – please indicate on your entry form any contribution. If you would like to sponsor Top Ten ribbons for a particular section at a cost of \$75 please contact the Show Secretary before 16th March 2010.

TROPHIES: The Club has a number of Perpetual silver trophies which are awarded for one year only to Supreme, Best in Show and R/U Best In Show Exhibits and remain the property of the NZSCA. Only current financial members may uplift trophies.

Perpetual trophies must be returned prior to close of entries the following year to the Trophy Steward in a clean condition. Please have any engraving of winner's names performed by a professional engraver. Entries may be refused if trophies are failed to be returned by due date.

MULTI-DRAW RAFFLE ON SHOW DAY: Donations gladly accepted. Please bring to the show on Saturday.

NZCF BENCHING LEVY:

The benching levy is \$4.00 per owner per judging. Joint ownership counts as one owner. A separate benching levy is payable when different owners reside at the same address.

DEFINITION OF TERMS USED

CAT	Cat of any gender, 9 months and over on day of the show
KITTEN	Kitten of any gender, 4 months or over and under 9 months on the day of the show
OPEN	Class in which Cats compete for NZCF Inc. Challenge Certificates
JUNIOR	Cat aged between 9 months to 2 years on the day of the show
INTERMEDIATE	Cat aged between 2 and 5 years on the day of the show
SENIOR	Cat aged between 5 and 7 years on the day of the show
VETERAN	Cat aged 7 years and over on the day of the show

BREEDERS AWARD OF MERIT A Breeders Award of Merit if offered by the NZCF Inc. to the breeder of the exhibit which, in the opinion of the judge, is most worthy of the Award. One Breeders Award of Merit will be offered in each entire cat and entire kitten section, and one jointly to the N/S Cat and N/S Kitten section.				

REGULATIONS FOR THIS SHOW *** PLEASE READ CAREFULLY ***

- This Show is held under the Rules and By-Laws of the NZ Cat Fancy Inc. and all exhibitors are deemed to have agreed to abide by such regulations.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to amend prize lists and refuse entries without giving any reason.
- Exhibitors requiring receipts must send a stamped self-addressed envelope for return of receipt. All cheques are to be made payable to N.Z. Siamese Cat Association Inc. and crossed.
- Declawed or de-voiced cats or kittens, or if any body parts are pierced for the purpose of applying an embellishment, or females that are obviously in kitten or entire male cats without both testicles palpable beyond the stomach wall, shall not be eligible for entry in any section.
- Entry fees will be refunded, less 25% for bookwork involved, where a certificate of illness signed by a veterinarian is in the Show Secretary's hands no later than 5.00 pm on the Friday prior to the show.
- Exhibits must be brought to the show in a secure container. Show Rules require that carry cages be left below exhibition cages in the hall to facilitate evacuation of exhibits in the event of an emergency.
- All exhibits must have CLEAN EARS AND COATS FREE FROM RINGWORM, MANGE, FLEAS, etc.
- No exhibitor shall exhibit a cat which to his/her knowledge, at the date of the show, has been exposed to any INFECTIOUS or CONTAGIOUS ILLNESS within the period of **21 days prior to the date of the show**, and no cat may be exhibited if the exhibitor has had any such illness in his/her cattery or home during that period.
- The cage number and exhibitor passes to be obtained from the Tally Clerk before exhibits are caged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for their exhibits and placing them in their correct classes and cages. Only exhibits registered with the NZCF Inc. or those with prior approval are eligible to enter this show.
- At least one qualified Veterinary Surgeon will be in attendance to examine each exhibit. All exhibits entering the hall will be vetted, and once in the hall may not be removed without the permission of the Show Manager. If, in his opinion, any exhibit is not fit to remain at the show, the exhibit/s shall be removed from competition and removed from the hall. Other exhibits and the exhibitors may be barred as the Veterinary Surgeon sees fit and entry fees forfeited. The examining Veterinary Surgeon's decision shall be final.
- Any exhibit presented at a NZCF Inc. show with a veterinary certificate (NON-CONTAGIOUS) shall be thoroughly examined by the officiating Veterinary Surgeon. The examining Veterinary Surgeon's word is final.
- Only those exhibits cleared by the Veterinary Surgeon may remain in the hall. Any exhibit declared unfit for exhibition will receive an NZCF rejection certificate and must be removed from the hall immediately. The examining veterinarian's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Exhibitors having a Veterinary Certificate providing clearance from a contagious or infectious illness shall present the original (photocopies are not acceptable) dated certificate to the Show Manager.

16. Cages and litter supplied by the Club. NO CLAY or GRIT TYPE LITTER ALLOWED IN THE HALL. Exhibitors to supply white or clear plastic toilet trays.
17. No interior or exterior decorations or distinguishing marks or objects to be allowed in or on the cages during judging and it will be an instruction to the Judge to pass any cage so marked. PLAIN WHITE BEDDING and DRAPES ONLY. Water Bowls and white covered hot water bottles may be in the cage during judging. EXHIBITS WITHOUT WHITE BEDDING SHALL NOT BE JUDGED.
18. The Club reserves the right of admission, and persons behaving in an unseemly manner will be asked to leave the premises.
19. Aerosol sprays and kitty litter must not be used in the Show Hall. Smoking is not permitted in either the hall or grounds.
20. After vetting and once judging commences no exhibit may be removed from its cage other than by the Judge or by express permission of the Show Manager. No exhibit may be removed from its cage or from the Show Hall before the close of the Show except at the discretion of the Show Manager.
21. All exhibits claws should be clipped prior to the show.
22. Any cat/kitten exhibited at this show shall be bred by the exhibitors in whose name it is entered or shall have been transferred to the exhibitors prior to the date of the show in accordance with NZCF Inc Show Rules & By Laws.
